Please find attached our manuscript entitled "New records and preliminary reproductive aspects of elasmobranchs of the Trindade-Martin Vaz insular complex", to be considered for publication as a *Scientific Note* in *Oecologia Australis*.

In this study, we reported some new information on reproductive aspects of elasmobranchs at the Trindade-Martin Vaz insular complex, including data for blue sharks (*Prionace glauca*) and pelagic stingrays (*Pteroplatytrygon violacea*). We also present new records for the species: *Isurus oxyrhincus, Sphyrna zygaena, Alopias superciliosus, Carcharhinus longimanus* and *Galeocerdo cuvier*.
