I am writing to submit our manuscript entitled, "Medium and large size mammals at the Urucum Massif, Mato Grosso do Sul, Brazil: species richness, relative abundance and activity patterns revealed by camera trapping" for consideration for publication in **Oecologia Australis**.

This study aimed to contribute to the body of knowledge on terrestrial mammalian species occurring at the Urucum Massif (UM), one of the most important areas for Iron and Manganese mining in Brazil, via camera trapping surveys carried out in this region. Moreover, we sought to verify the impact of mining on their activity. Thus, the goal of this study is to estimate species richness (S) of medium to large-sized mammals occurring in the Urucum Massif, as well as to estimate their relative abundance and activity patterns. We found 25 species of medium to large-sized mammals in the Urucum Massif. Of all the species recorded, 28% (n=7) and 12% (n=3) are threatened nationally and globally, respectively. Thus, the present study reported about 80% of the medium to large size mammalian species recorded in a previous study in the Urucum region, just using camera trapping as survey method. Moreover, we found potential impact of mining on collared-peccary activity patterns. Due to the scarcity of protected areas in the UM, we recommend long term mammalian monitoring, besides ecological studies, to support conservation measures for this group in the region.
