We are submitting the manuscript entitled "First record of twin fetuses of South American sea lion in the southern Brazilian coast" to be considered for publication as a short communication on Oecologia Australis. This is an original manuscript reporting the first known occurrence of twinning in South American sea lions in the South American coast. We describe this occurrence with as much detail as possible, including pictures. We also highlight the unusual circumstances found which include the stranding of the pregnant female away from the closest breeding colony in a period when most pups were being born, and poor development of fetuses.
