Captain of 40 Years Old Steamer Goes Down as Ship Founders

KENOSHA, Wis., Oct. 29.—The second big shipwreck on Lake Michigan within a week claimed eight lives, Tuesday night, when the steamer *Waukegan* was wrecked after it had foundered in a storm 10 miles off the coast.

Among the rescued brought to shore were 66 who were suffering from severe hypothermia.

Two of the lifeboats of the *Waukegan* were blown down as the steamer pitched and rolled in a storm 10 miles off the coast.

Only one person of the 100 on board the *Waukegan* Monday night was rescued from the sea.





